Term 2	Club	Teacher
Tuesday 3rd Nov - 8th December	Small World	Mrs Jeffery
We will be exploring the world around us using the small world resources (eg, figures, farms, the ocean) that represent our environment, but in miniature.		
Thursday 5th Nov -10th December	Let's Play	Mrs Russam
The children will have fun building and creating with different toys such as cars, trains, building blocks and magnet blocks. They will also have the chance to draw, colour, and make their own designs, using their imagination and enjoying being creative.
